FLAG RETIREMENT

The United States Flag Code, Title 4, Section 8k states that "The Flag, when it is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem of display, should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning."On March 24th members of VFW Calabash Post 7288 joined forces with members from Calabash American Legion Post 503 to accomplish that task. Over several hours, more than 2500 flags were retired in a burn pit behind the Calabash Firehouse. VFW Calabash Post 7288 and American Legion Post 503, along with the Elks Club have receptacles in which the public may deposit tattered and worn American flags for proper disposal later.
